He announced a tentative schedule for the construction on Benton Airpark. He emphasized "tentative" schedule. Construction begins May 29, 2012. In the beginning the airpark will be closed "nights" (1800hrs to 0600hrs) for runway lights replacements. Construction contract is 120 days. Runway will be closed from July 5 thru July 22, 2012 (17 days).
