Minutes of the last meeting: Motion by Wayne P. and Second by Dick W. that the Minutes be approved. Motion passed.

Treasurer's report: Pres. Jim B. presented the Financial Report as prepared by Barbara C. as of this date. Motion by Wayne P. and second by Dick W. that the current month's report be accepted. Motion passed.
