OLD BUSINESS:

1. The engine preheater was sold for \$250.00; shipping was \$84.79 leaving a net of \$165.21 for the chapter.
2. There has been no update on the search for a trailer for the new flight simulator.
3. Young Eagles: An event is planned for September 18, 2021 at Benton Airpark. A special event and safety plan will need to be submitted to the City of Redding.
4. Shasta County Office of Education (SCOE) stem event will be held at the Anderson fairgrounds in November. We hope to have a table with information and the simulator at the event.
5. The Benton Air Fair will be on October 16, 2021. The flight simulator will be at the event. After the Air Fair, there will be an "October Fest" at the Quonset Hut. The chapter will offer "Brats" and sauerkraut. If the City of Redding approves, there would also be overnight camping on the lawn.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Young Eagles Workshop: The board voted to purchase enough material for a Young Eagles Workshop for 20 kids (\$50.00). This event will probably coincide with a Young Eagles event.
2. The meeting on August 17 will be Taco Salad. Irwin Fust will make a presentation on Basic Med.

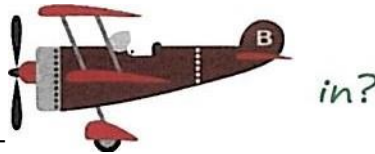

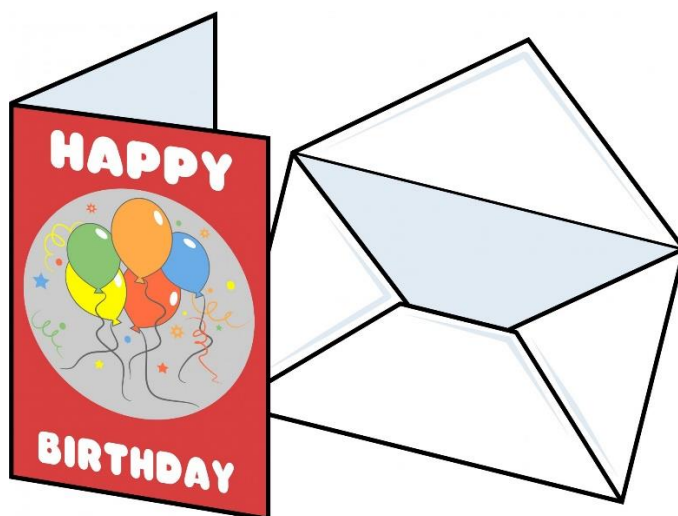
